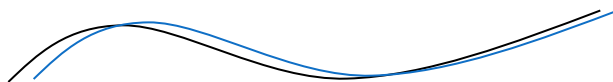
First Grants Issued

We first started raising money in 2017. By the end of 2018, that money raised in 2017 had been invested for a full year. Therefore, in April 2019, we issued the following grants from the 2018 earnings of the endowment fund:

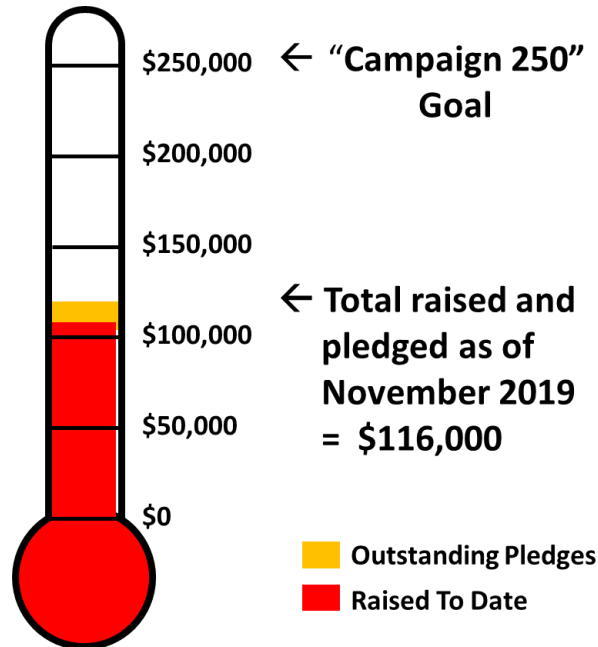
- ♪ \$895 for a new bass drum and cover for Philomath Middle School
- ♪ \$1,280 for handrails for the back of the risers used by Philomath Elementary School

Campaign 250

As of November 2019, we have raised over \$116,000 in gifts and pledges. Now, the PPABF Board is excited to announce “Campaign 250” — our focused effort to reach \$250,000 in our endowment fund in the coming year. With that amount of capital, the Board would be able to grant approximately \$10,000 to the performing arts programs each year, every year, forever.
