First Grants Issued

We first started raising money in 2017. By the end of 2018, that money raised in 2017 had been invested for a full year. Therefore, in April 2019, we issued the following grants from the 2018 earnings of the endowment fund:

- \$895 for a new bass drum and cover for Philomath Middle School
- \$1,280 for handrails for the back of the risers used by Philomath Elementary School
